The company that made most microphone stands (Atlas Sound) sold a peculiar gadget consisting of a short chrome plated pipe with the standard 5/8-27 mike thread, attached to a special C-clamp suitable for fastening to shelf or pipe. They called it a SKYHOOK. That seemed like a good name for a ham club's newsletter.


